The Queens Civic Congress elected **Corey B. Bearak** of Bellerose to a third (one-year) term as President, Monday evening, Oct. 19, preceding a forum Health Care - Health Insurance, sponsored by the Borough-wide coalition of more than 110 community and neighborhood groups representing tenants, co-op and condo owners and homeowners living in every part of Queens, at the Al Oerter Recreation Center in Flushing.

In addition to Bearak (North Bellerose Civic Association), Queens Civic Congress members re-elected Executive Vice President **Patricia Dolan** (Kew Gardens Hills Civic Association), Treasurer **James Trent** (Creedmoor Civic Association, Secretary **Seymour Schwartz** (Briarwood Civic Association) and Vice Presidents **Tyler Cassell** (North Flushing Civic Association), **Rich Hellenbrecht** (Bellerose-Commonwealth Civic Association), **Paul Kerzner** (Ridgewood Property Owners and Civic Association), **David Kulick** (Flushing on the Hill Taxpayers Association), **Barbara Larkin** (Belle Harbor Property Owners Association), **Audrey Lucas** (Southeast Queens Concerned Neighbors), **Kathy Masi** (Glendale Civic Association of Queens), **Harbachan Singh** (Holliswood Civic Association), **Edwin Westley** (Jackson Heights Beautification Group) and **Dorothy Woo** (Holly Civic Association). **Paul Graziano** was elected as a Vice President.

According to QCC's By-Laws, President Emeritus **Sean Walsh** and Founders **Robert Harris** and **Albert Greenblatt** remain on the QCC executive committee. The installation of officers takes place, Sunday, Dec. 6, at the Douglaston Club as part of the Annual Queens Civic Congress Legislative Reception.
